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Dual Enrollment Program

State of Florida Dual Enrollment Eligibility Requirements

(Per s. 1007.271, Florida Statutes) To participate in dual enrollment, students must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be enrolled as a student in a Florida public or nonpublic secondary school (grades 6–12) or in a home education program.
- Have a 3.0 unweighted high school GPA to enroll in college credit courses, or a 2.0 unweighted high school GPA to enroll in career dual enrollment courses.
- For college credits, demonstrate college readiness as outlined in Rule 6A-10.0315, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), pursuant to Rule 6A-14.064, F.A.C.
- Meet any additional eligibility criteria specified by the postsecondary institution in the Dual Enrollment Articulation Agreement.
- Not be scheduled to graduate from high school prior to the completion of the dual enrollment course.

Private (Non-Public) School Students

According to s. 1007.271(24), F.S., each eligible postsecondary institution must enter into a private school articulation agreement with each private school in its geographic service area seeking to offer dual enrollment courses, including students with disabilities.

For Florida private high school students, it is recommended that:

- A parent or guardian confirms that the private school has entered into a private school articulation agreement with an eligible postsecondary institution.
- A parent or guardian contacts the Dual Enrollment Coordinator at the desired institution to ensure successful enrollment.



Eligibility



RFM Requirements

- Must be an actively-enrolled RFM student
- 3.0 minimum GPA
 - Must maintain eligibility requirements for specific program articulation agreement
- No disciplinary action/issues
- No attendance issues
- Obtain qualifying test scores

Academic Dual Enrollment-TSC



For academic dual enrollment participants, the following timeline is suggested to provide a reasonable pace for completion of an A.A. or A.S. degree:

- 8th/9th Grade-begin with 1 course per semester
- 10th Grade- 2 courses per semester
- 11th Grade-3 courses per semester
- 12th Grade-4 courses per semester with a GPA of 3.5
 - Students are permitted to enroll as “early admit” & take up to 15 credit hours (5 courses) senior year if they have an overall GPA of 3.5 or higher

TSC Eligibility continued...



****Summer June Express Sessions****

All eligible and participating students (in grades 9 through 11) are permitted to take up to 3 courses during the Summer June Express session. June Express typically runs from the last full week of June through the first full week of August.

- For students to be able to take the PERT test through Tallahassee State College, students will need to apply to TSC. Please click the link below to complete the application. You will need a valid photo ID (drivers license, driver's permit, passport photo, or school ID).
- All interested students must have a minimum 3.0 gpa to be considered for participation.
 - If students have taken the PERT Test before, they will be required to pay a \$4 fee at the TSC Testing Center.

Eligibility-Florida State University



Students Must:

- Be a local secondary student with at least a 3.9 weighted cumulative high school GPA in grades 11 or 12, **and no semester grades below C.**
- Have a minimum of 12 graded credits [by start of the application term] to include:
 - 2 English Credits
 - 2 Mathematics credits, one of which must be Algebra II or higher
 - 1 Science credit with lab
 - 1 Social Studies credit
- Have the following minimum test scores:
 - ACT Composite-26
 - Reading-19
 - English-19
 - Math-21

Eligibility-Florida State University



Students Must:

- SAT
 - Total Score-1230
 - Reading & Writing-490
 - Math-480
- Classic Learning Test (CLT)
 - Composite-86
 - Verbal Reasoning/Grammar & Writing (combined score)-38
 - Quantitative Reasoning-16
- Provide proof of immunizations and complete the University's health forms.
- Be free of (or reviewed and cleared by the Office of Admissions in light of) any charges of scholastic or behavioral misconduct, violation of the law, or felony charge (details in application).
- Maintain a 3.0 FSU GPA (FSU courses only) to continue in the Dual Enrollment Program..

Eligibility- University of South Florida



Students Must:

- SAT
 - Total Score-1100
 - Reading & Writing-550
 - Math-550
- Classic Learning Test (CLT)
 - Composite-86
 - Verbal Reasoning/Grammar & Writing (combined score)-38
 - Quantitative Reasoning-16
- Be free of (or reviewed and cleared by the Office of Admissions in light of) any charges of scholastic or behavioral misconduct, violation of the law, or felony charge (details in application).
- Maintain a 3.0 USF GPA to continue in the Dual Enrollment Program..

Eligibility-Gadsden Technical College



- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Applicants under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian to give permission to enroll.
- Provide a U.S. driver's license, Department of State ID card, U.S. passport, or U.S. military ID card. This will need to be uploaded in the online application.
- REFERENCES (For Dual Enrolled High School Students): High school students are required to submit two (2) reference forms (the reference form must be printed from the reference section in the online application).

Eligibility-Lively Technical College



- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Must have completed a minimum of 11 high school credits at the time of application
- Must have a minimum 2.0 GPA (Lively), 2.5 minimum (RFM)
